Information Pack.

Schedule of the day:

- Drop off between 9.00-9.30 (All adults need to sign their children in before leaving)
- 9.45-16.00 All children participate in Ski or Snowboard lessons (chosen on booking), Toboggan, Sno-Tube and Viper. All children are provided with a hot meal at lunch time with unlimited water and squash offered throughout the day.
- 16.00 Collection

Drop off and collection:

Our activity leaders will meet you in the Alpine Lodge from 9.00am which can be accessed through our main reception. You will be required to sign your child/children in and fill out any necessary paperwork. At this point you will be asked for a password for when you collect your child/children. If someone is picking them up on your behalf, they will need to know the password. You are required to pick up your child/children at 16.00.

Medical Details: There is a medical form at the end of the pack. Please complete this and an **Administering Medication Form** on the day if your child has medication to be taken on the day.

Any child/children with Additional Needs a parent/guardian is required to remain on site.

What to bring: -

- Refillable water bottle with their name on
- Waterproof Jacket
- Sensible shoes for activities (no flip/flops, crocs or open toe sandals)
- Long sleeved top, long trousers and pair of gloves for skiing/boarding

We don't recommend they bring: -

- Expensive/best clothing
- Handheld games consoles/music devices or Mobile phones
- Large amounts of money

N.B Please label all personnel belongings. PSC cannot be held responsible for any loss of or damage to belongings.

Behaviour Policy: - We have a discipline procedure in place to ensure that positive behaviour is encouraged and all children are respected and given equal attention.

Please read and sign to confirm your agreement.

- Incident 1 Explain to child why their behaviour is unacceptable and what implications their behaviour has on others. Explain to the child they have been given a warning
- Incident 2 Explain to child as above. Child will be taken to the Duty Manager and the Activity Leader will explain the child's behaviour. The Duty Manager will decide whether or not to contact the parent/guardian and explain the child's behaviour.
- Incident 3 (If the same behaviour continues) Explain to child as above. Child will be taken to the Duty Manager who will call the parent/guardian and agree on a suitable solution (this may include asking the parent to come and collect the child).
